

STARRING

Charlie Marcus (Fred Graham): Charlie's been singing and dancing on Broadway since the 1980's and started his career in the original company of A Chorus Line. While he won neither a medal nor an Oscar for his portrayal as 3rd Drunken Buccaneer From The Left in Peter Pan, his mother was still very proud. His most recent Broadway run was in the Original company of A Bronx Tale, directed by Robert DeNiro and starring Oscar nominee Chazz Palminteri. ORCHESTRA

The South Shore Symphony was first organized in the Five Towns in 1983. In 1991, led by President and Principal Cellist Wayne Lipton, the orchestra moved to Rockville Centre. While it is largely made up of volunteer musicians, it has become one of the premier performing ensembles of Long Island. For over ten years, the orchestra has been the resident orchestra at the Madison Theatre and has performed classical concerts, opera, musicals, jazz works and ballets with such artists as Jimmy Webb, Tony Danza, Judy Collins, Kelly O'Hara, Keith Emerson, and Matthew Morrison to name a few.

The Orchestra performs yearly just after Thanksgiving in a full production of the Nutcracker Ballet as well as a spectacular fireworks Concert with Grucci Fireworks in July. It collaborates with the Cap 21 program and with Producer Angelo Fraboni in various concert versions and fully staged musicals at the Madison Theatre at Molloy University.

This year it will perform at Carnegie Hall in on Tuesday, November 25, 2025 with host Seth Rudetsky and some of Broadway's Greatest stars as a fund raiser for The Arts at Molloy.


